Animation 1 hr 40 mins (PG)

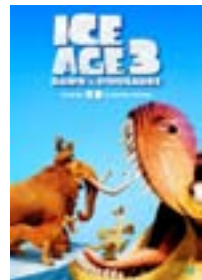
