Bingara Wattle Arts and Crafts opened in March 2011 with the goal of providing an outlet for the many talented people in the area.

The shop is located in the middle of the main street of Bingara (next to the newsagency) and is run by local ladies who volunteer their time.

The shop offers goods such as leatherwork, folk art, lead lighting, photography, paintings, quilting, gift cards, wood work, silver work, children's and baby clothes, knitted items, toys, garden ornaments, metalwork, jewellery, soaps, creams, dog coats and furniture.

The business is run as a cooperative with an annual membership fee, and a commission paid from sales, which then goes back into the community. Community organisations who have benefited in the past include the Touriandi Nursing Home, Bingara Central School and the Toy Library.

The coop has a number of members spread over a very wide area including Grafton, Coolamon, Narrabri, Central Coast, Gladstone in QLD and Yea VIC just to name a few, and of course Bingara.
