\$3 per Woodwork entry
No entry fee for children's art, pottery
or photography
4. The organisers will retain a sales commission of
20% for paintings and drawings, and 15% for photographs
pottery, ceramics and other craft items.
5. The Judge's decision will be final and no
correspondence will be entered into regarding
such a decision.
6. The organisers reserve the right to exercise their
discretion concerning the hanging of entries.
7. The organisers reserve the right to reproduce
any pictures or work in the press or on TV.
The signed entry form is evidence of the
Artist's consent.
