Bush Tranquillity

The "blue hills" of Bingara are caused by the dominant cypress pine and ironbark trees. There are magical spots hidden away in these hills with many beautiful streams, groves, cascades and waterfalls.

The night sky is spectacular - starry, starry nights abound. Watch the moonrise over the Gwydir, and feel a peace that you may have forgotten existed.

Batterham Lookout offers a panorama of the town and westward down the Gwydir Valley. It is a great spot to view spectacular sunsets.

Upper Bingara The loop road to Upper Bingara cuts through the serpentine rocks of the Peel Fault. Along the road is a magnificent stand of grass trees (xanthorea australis). These grass trees include some of the largest and oldest in Australia.
